## **ADMISSIONS INFORMATION**

Willowwind is a small, independent school with dual accreditation through the Independent Schools Association of the Central States (ISACS) and the State of Iowa Department of Education. Willowwind School serves students in preschool through sixth grade. We strive for a balanced mix of age and gender in each of our multi-age classrooms. Our application process is designed as a dialogue between family and school. Together we discuss the student's needs and the school's philosophy and resources to determine if Willowwind is the right fit for the student, the family and the school. Willowwind School considers applications for kindergarten students who will turn five by September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Due to a limited number of available spaces in our **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**, *Admissions occurs on a rolling basis and we maintain a waiting list after reaching capacity*. Our enrollment is determined by the following priorities: current Willowwind students, current Willowwind siblings, current Willowwind staff children, years of enrollment the family has in the school, teacher recommendations, and interview with child and family (if necessary). Each application is reviewed in the order it has been received.

In order for your child's application to be reviewed and/ or your child be placed on the waiting list families <u>must</u> complete the application and return to Willowwind School with a one-time \$100.00 application fee. The application fee is only refunded if we do NOT have a space for your child. If you choose not to accept an available position, the application fee is forfeited. Please submit application as soon as the decision is made to pursue a Willowwind education so your child's application may be reviewed and/ or your child placed on the waiting list. An enrollment contract is sent following acceptance.

Students at Willowwind come from Iowa City and the surrounding areas. They come from a wide spectrum of ethnic, religious, socio-economic, and academic backgrounds. Limited K-6 financial aid is available. An online financial aid application for K-6 students is available after January 31st of every calendar year through FACTS Grant and Aid (link on the Willowwind website). A financial aid committee makes recommendations on possible gift levels after receiving information from the financial aid application service.

Due to a limited number of available spaces in our **PRESCHOOL**, *Admissions occurs on a rolling basis and we maintain a waiting list after reaching capacity*. Our enrollment is determined by the following priorities: balance of three-year olds for the beginning of each year, current Willowwind students, current Willowwind siblings, Willowwind staff children, family commitment (years of enrollment to school now or in the past), transfers, balance for classrooms, all criteria examined within context of waiting list and application. Each application is reviewed in the order it has been received.

In order for your child's application to be reviewed and/or your child be placed on the waiting list, families <u>must</u> complete the application and return to Willowwind School with a one-time \$100.00 application fee. The application fee is only refunded if we do NOT have a space for your child. If you choose not to accept an available position, the application fee is forfeited. Please submit an application as soon as the decision is made to pursue a Willowwind education so your child's application may be reviewed and/ or your child placed on the waiting list. An enrollment contract is sent following acceptance.
