LEGO ROBOTICS (GRADES 1-6)

Mondays, 3:30-4:30 PM with Darla Burr and Emily Hill

Robotics provides a real-life simulation of the complex engineering challenges that exist in the industry. This course encourages students to use their critical thinking and teamwork skills, while the students build robots together and create something amazing.

INTRO TO BASKETBALL (GRADES 2-6)

This extra curricular program will aim to improve students' overall understanding and confidence in the game of basketball. While improving the fundamentals of basketball, students will work on footwork, shooting, passing, dribbling, rebounding, defense, overall athleticism, and explosiveness through a multitude of drills. Students' will also work on teamwork through scrimmaging and multi person drills.

MIX MEDIA ART (GRADES 2-6)

Delve into techniques at your own pace within a nurturing environment. Mixed media paintings encourage us to step out of the box, and to explore endless possibilities, by breaking boundaries between different types of paint, inks, and techniques (for example watercolor + acrylics, collage + stenciling).

TIPPI PRO (K-2)

Tuesdays, 3:30-4:30 PM with Tippi Toes Instructors

Tippi Pro dance class is perfect for the growing dancer who is interested in more time learning ballet choreography. We keep all of our classes upbeat and fun and this class will teach your dancer more advanced ballet steps, while keeping the energy of class positive, fun and engaging every week. Cost: \$230; \$210 for full-time ASP enrollees



INTRODUCTION TO TAEKWONDO (GRADES PRE-K-6)

Tuesdays at 3:30-4:30 PM and Thursdays at 2:30- 3:30 PM with Grandmaster Ms. Lonnie Matthews 8th Dan Black Belt and Mr. Emmerson Bennett 2nd Dan Black Belt

The focus of all Mireu Martial Arts Classes is on character development, physical fitness, and self-defense, rather than fighting. The overarching goal is in building student's self-esteem and self-confidence. The introductory program is for all ages 4 to adult. Optional yellow belt promotion test at the end of the session at Mireu Martial Arts main school in Coralville for \$75. Cost: \$415 includes tuition, uniform, belt, patches and white belt curriculum.; \$400 for full-time ASP enrollees



JUNIOR SCIENTIST (GRADE PRE-K-2)

Wednesdays 3:30 - 4:30 PM with Veronica Armstrong

Students will learn about how scientists work - observing, recording, experimenting and making mistakes along the way! Each week they will learn about a scientist and the kinds of work they do. They will create a hypothesis, conduct a hands on experiment and talk about what went well and what maybe didn't go as planned. Kids should wear play clothes because sometimes science is messy!

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INTRO TO CODING (GRADES 3-6)

Wednesday, 3:30-4:30 PM with Zach Burr

Teaching the basics of coding, prints ints and strings, and building skills of the computer science to teach them how to make and fix lines of code. We will finish this class by teaching the students how to make their own codebased game!

MINI TIPPI (PRE-K)

Thursdays, 3:30-4:30 PM with Tippi Toes Instructors

We incorporate a mix of the three types of dance during class time using high-energy music. Students learn choreography to multiple dances throughout the year and get to show off their moves at recital time! Our original music separates Tippi Toes dance classes from all the rest and we guarantee big smiles and lots of fun every single class! Students will be grouped by age and our staff is trained to customize the class according to the age of the kiddos!

Cost: \$300; \$280 for full-time ASP enrollees



DUNGEONS AND DRAGONS (GRADES 2-6)

REGISTRATION & POLICIES

WHO CAN REGISTER

Public, private, and home-schooled students in preschool through Grade 6 are invited to participate. Elementary students should register based on the grade they are in for the 2023-2024 school year. For preschool programs, students must be at least four years old and toilet-trained. Willowwind provides equal opportunity to participate in programs and does not discriminate by gender, sexual orientation, marital status, socioeconomic status, disability, race, national origin, color, religion, or creed.

PAYMENT & FEES

A deposit of 50% will be required at the time of registration for all after school enrichment programs (the registration fee will be waived). Any remaining tuition will be billed in equal monthly installments throughout the spring (paid in full by March 29th, 2024). If payment is not made in full when the payment plan is complete, we reserve the right to cancel your registration. We process all registrations in the order in which they are received. We accept registrations as long as they are prior to the registration deadline. We do not offer prorated tuition for absences or late starts. We cannot accommodate drop-ins.

HOW TO REGISTER

Returning students will use their existing Schooldoc account and new families will create an account for the Enrichment Program registration. Registration can be completed at app.schooldoc.com/register/willowwind.

ATTENDANCE

In order to get the most out of each class, we expect children to attend every day of their enrolled classes, except in the case of illness or emergency. Tuition will not be prorated and refunds will not be issued for missed classes.

LATE PICK-UP

- ASP drop-in fee (\$20) will be charged for each instance of a late pick up.
- If an emergency should occur and the family is unable to arrive on time to pick up a child, please call the school to notify the staff of the late pick-up time.

REGISTRATION & POLICIES

BEHAVIOR

All children have the right to learn in a safe classroom that is free from excessive distraction. When a child's behavior becomes a distraction, the faculty and staff use a number of strategies to mitigate the issue. They begin with reteaching, reinforcing, and acknowledging appropriate behavior, and then move on to redirecting the individual student. If a child is unable to correct their behavior or is unresponsive to teacher interventions, Willowwind reserves the right to excuse the child from the Enrichment Program. Refunds will not be made for current class days not attended due to dismissal.

After school program (ASP)

Our After School Programs (ASP) is available for preK through sixth grade students. Students are invited to join ASP while they await the start of their enrichment class and snack will be provided after enrichment if desired. There is no cost to join ASP before the start of your enrichment class. Willowwind ASP begins at 3:15pm on M/T/W. ASP begins at 2:00pm on Thursdays. New families can expect an email from our Programs Coordinator to discuss the required forms needed to participate in Willowwind's after school program.

CLASS CANCELLATION POLICIES

We want all students to be satisfied with their experiences at Willowwind School. If after attending the first day of class, you decide that you do not wish to continue, let us know before the second class and your tuition will become a credit, which you may use toward another available space in a fall 2024 class. After the second day of class, we will not make any tuition or enrollment adjustments.

- If you cancel your registration at any time, tuition will not be refunded.
- If tuition has not been paid in full by the time the monthly payment plan is complete, and no action to cancel has been taken, no refund or class credit will be issued and the registration will be terminated.
- Cancellation by Willowwind: We reserve the right to cancel a class if enrollment is insufficient. Any tuition paid will be refunded in full.
